INTRODUCTION

1) From Yorkshire

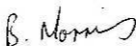
2) Not there when the "Brian Morris was not there" game was first played and therefore

INTRODUCTION

This is the second meeting of the Fat ** Stag Committee. It was decided to use the minutes of the 1st meeting as a basis for this meeting.

Action 2.10: Mr Tanner to interview Miss Lisle with respect to her skills in the following:

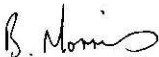
